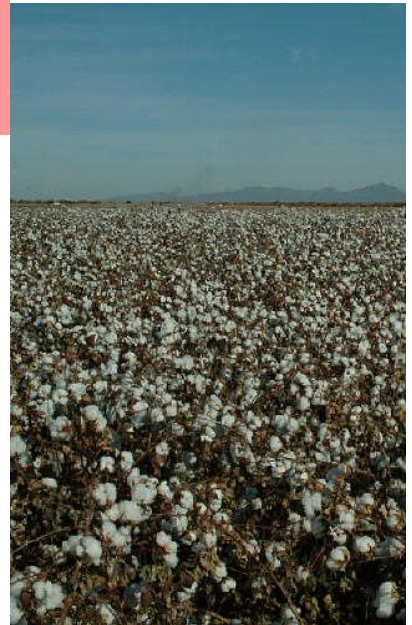
A Mission Field? Right Here. Right Now.

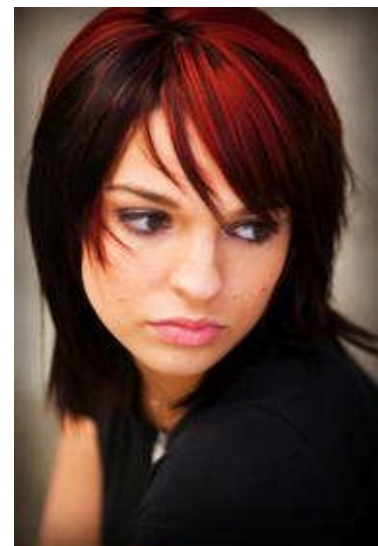
