



Executive Director's Commentary

As most of you know, our medical clinic began operating this past May. We were blessed with help from NIFLA (National Institute of Family and Life Advocates), Focus on the Family, and a major donor that provided us training and resources which included our ultrasound machine.

In 2010, we saw 23 babies saved! Out of 119 pregnancy tests, only 59 were positive. And out of 59 positive tests, 33 were abortion at-risk. **That's nearly 70% of our abortion-minded, abortion-vulnerable women choosing life for their unborn child.** The Gospel was also shared 123 times with 8 women professing faith in Jesus.

But even as we celebrate this last year, we recognize our need to reach more abortion at-risk women. There were 32,066 abortions in Georgia in 2008 (our latest statistics on record). There were 404 abortions in our area alone. This area includes women from Tifton and the surrounding counties up to 1 hour away of whom we see on a regular basis.

In an effort to better use our resources that you have entrusted to us, we have decided to become an OT (Optimization Tool) Medical Center. We have overhauled the entire service model in an effort to be focused and intentional when interfacing with women at risk for getting an abortion. The Optimization Tool is designed to help us be more efficient in reaching these women.

Our mission is to erase the (perceived) need for abortion through effectively serving pregnant, at-risk women by transforming their fear (of the unknown) into confidence (for the future of their baby).

Our vision is to reach the right women (abortion at-risk), at the right time (pregnant), and serve them in the right way (professional, confidential) for the greatest possible gain on behalf of patients, babies, staff, donors, the organization, the community and God.

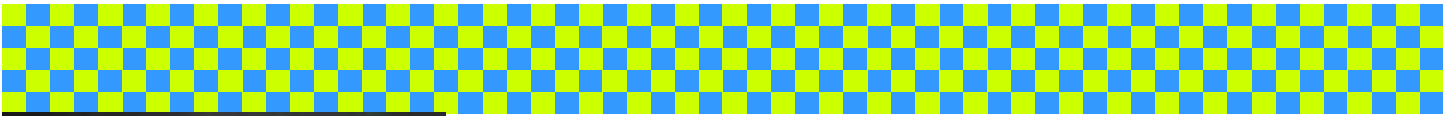

Attempting to justify her own abortion in 1973, she was led into the abortion industry. This resulted in Carol's ownership interest in two clinics in the Dallas/Fort Worth Metroplex. In 1983, Carol experienced a change in her life when she came to know Jesus Christ as her personal Savior. Her perspective offers an inside look at the abortion industry through the eyes of a former insider.

Carol is the only woman with such experience working full time in the pro-women movement. She is committed to safe guarding the health of women and their babies all over our nation, as well as presenting "the truth" about the abortion issue, which she refers to as the mission field of the nineties.

That's why all of us at the Pregnancy Care Center want to begin conversations with you—conversations that build relationships and in turn, strengthen this ministry.

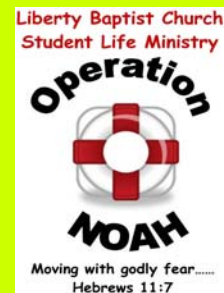
You get *our* information. Now we want to talk with you about *your* hopes, *your* dreams for our future as we create a culture of life in Tifton and beyond.
