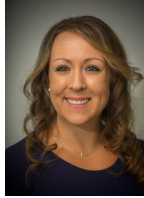

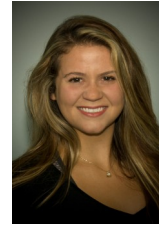
# The Pregnancy Care Center Welcomes....

## Bracelets To Remember



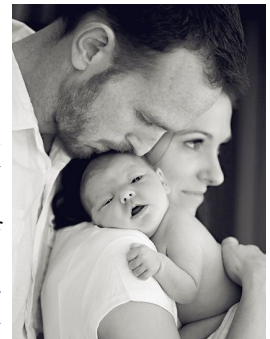
**“He will cover you with his pinions, and under his wing you will find refuge; his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.”**
