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A Place Where We Celebrate (True) Choice

Dear Defender of Life,

Recently, we saw a patient who was abortion-minded. After our services, she let us know that she had not changed her mind. We tried to reach her for follow-



up but we could not reach her at the number she had left us. A few weeks later, our Patient Resources Manager, Denise, happened to see her at her place of business. How we celebrated with joy when the patient told Denise that she had decided to continue her pregnancy. This patient came to us thinking her only choice was abortion. Thankfully, while she was at our clinic, she heard about other “choices.”

In the past, those who opposed ministries like ours would say about us, “Oh, those are the people who try to talk women out of abortions. They don’t provide women with **choice**.” This was a frustrating, inaccurate description but in many circles, the description stuck. Today, those people say the same thing—and it could not be more wrong. Their line of reasoning is that if we don’t provide abortion, we are somehow depriving women of their rights. Suddenly we are targeted as “anti-choice.”

But times have changed. Without question, we are the providers of choice. Should a woman want a picture of where she is in pregnancy, she comes to us for detailed information and for an ultrasound. If a couple considers adoption for their baby, we are many times their first choice. Should parenting be an option, where does a woman turn for help? Us, of course. And if a woman has been through an abortion and is suffering emotional pain and trauma, where does she turn? To the abortion clinic? Never. Instead, she comes to us—people who understand her hurt, who love her enough to listen to her and who will walk with her on her road to forgiveness and healing.

Choice, a catch-word in today’s world, has come to mean, “Abortion.” It is a shame, because choice actually means we are given options from which we can make an informed decision. And we want those options to be healthy ones.

Choice then, comes not from those who give but one answer to an unplanned pregnancy—but from us, PCC’s Women’s First Choice Medical. Here, a woman is given an opportunity to explore healthy pregnancy options such as parenting and adoption. In each case, a pregnancy is allowed to come to its intended conclusion: birth.

The truth about choice is simple: No self-respecting physician offers abortion as a healthy choice for pregnancy, just as no worthy physician offers cigarettes as a choice for the patient with high blood pressure (“Relax more—have a smoke!”). To do so is a hypocritical rationalization of the Hippocratic Oath.

So while others attempt to sway the public debate with carefully-chosen words, we truly offer choice—backing it up with practical resources to make those choices work. Choice? It’s found right here, every day.

You . . . Make the difference. Every time a mom chooses life, you are playing a role in honoring the Creator of Life. God uses ordinary people to accomplish extraordinary tasks. Throughout scripture, we do not see God using the famous, the rich, the movers and shakers. He uses people with open hearts who choose to follow His leading. Thank you for your faithful support! Nothing is so rewarding as seeing eyes light up when a life choice is made and a fearful young woman can rest confidently in a decision she has made. It is uplifting when she realizes she does have the choice to change her direction in life and she can start choosing today. She can choose life, not only for the life she is carrying, but for herself.
